



REQUIREMENTS OF FEDERAL ACQUISITION REGULATION JANUARY 2023

PURCHASING OPERATIONAL DIRECTION



This document, Requirements of Federal Acquisition Regulation, applies to all suppliers providing goods or services to Michelin North America, Inc. under a Master Agreement, Purchase Order or similar contract.

The following terms from 48 CFR (Code of Federal Regulation) and FAR 52.219-8 (Federal Acquisition Regulation) are applicable: "It is the policy of the United States that small business concerns, veteran-owned small business concerns, service-disabled veteran-owned small business concerns, HUBZone small business concerns, small disadvantaged business concerns, and women owned small business concerns shall have the maximum practicable opportunity to participate in performing contracts awarded by any Federal agency ... "

All Michelin North America suppliers hereby agree to carry out this policy in the awarding of subcontracts to the fullest extent consistent with the efficient performance of this contract. In accordance with Federal Acquisition Regulation 52.219-9, all contracts / purchase orders in excess of \$250,000 (\$750,000 for construction) requires the supplier/vendor to submit a commercial subcontracting plan to Michelin North America, Inc. This requirement does not apply to small business concerns or businesses located outside of the US, Canada or Mexico.
