<i>Bradypus torquatus</i>	Maned sloth	Vulnerable	Good; in all forests
<i>Chaetomys subspinosus</i>	Bristle-spined porcupine	Vulnerable	Good; found throughout
<i>Callicebus melanochir</i>	Bahia masked titi monkey	Vulnerable	Good; very large population
<i>Sapajus xanthosternos</i>	Yellow-breasted capuchin monkey	Critically endangered	Good; one of largest populations remaining

<i>Eleoscytalopus psychopompus</i>	Bahia tapaculo	Endangered	Good; distributed throughout wetlands, both in the forest, abandoned rubber groves, and active rubber plantation
<i>Procnias nudicollis</i>	Bare-throated bellbird	Vulnerable	Good; common in forest and recently re-colonized the abandoned rubber groves.
<i>Crax blumenbachii</i>	Red-billed curassow	Endangered	Good and growing; one of eight known populations remaining

<i>Bothrops pirajai</i>	Pirajai's lancehead	Vulnerable	Good; our reserve is the center of this Bahia endemic snake species range.
Plants			
<i>Arapatiella psilophylla</i>	Arapti	Vulnerable	Good; healthy population in the forest and we have planted several hundred trees in our restoration areas. This is a Bahia endemic.
<i>Begonia micheliniana</i>	Climbing Begonia	Critically endangered	Believed to be restricted to our region of Bahia
